We would like to let you know of two Educational Scholars Assistance Program (ESAP) Scholarship opportunities that are being offered for our students. The first opportunity is for all students who will be in 8th grade next year at St. Ignatius. You are eligible to compete for a \$500 ESAP Scholarship. ESAP is a privately funded grant program intended to support elementary Catholic education. One 7th grade girl and one 7th grade boy will be chosen from our school. The second opportunity is for the ESAP financial aid awards. These are available to families of students who will be entering the 5th-8th grade at St. Ignatius next year. Awards range from \$100-500 and are based on need as assessed by Private School Aide Service (PSAS). If you have completed the PSAS form for a Catholic high school, you will automatically be considered for ESAP awards. There is nothing further you need to do. Applications for both opportunities are available at www.elderhs.org. (Elder is helping administer the program- this is not a recruiting move!) Once there, click "ESAP" on the left side. Scholarship applications are due **March 1, 2010**. For more information, please see the flyer available in our school office or contact Maureen Regan at 921-3744 ext. 3417.

St. Ignatius Parish also offers two forms of tuition assistance. As you know, just about everyone receives the parish subsidy as a support from other parishioners. (This is the subsidy that you qualify for by establishing continuous participation in the liturgical life of the parish.) The second form of tuition assistance is through PSAS and is need based. Paper application forms are available in the parish office, and soon the form will be available on our web site.

Thanks for your support of our paper-recycling program. We now have two bins at the school and the reimbursement check we received this month was for \$71. When we began our program in October 2006, our first monthly check was \$1.77.

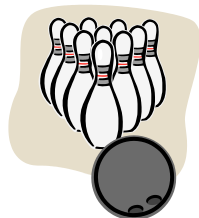
